The Charles Louis Davis DVM Foundation will be conducting an eight-hour continuing education symposium entitled "Diagnostic Pathology of Bovine Diseases" on October 17, 2014. Course Director Matt Kiupel (Michigan State University) and invited guest lecturers Klaus Buergelt (University of Florida) and Thomas Herdt (Michigan State University). The following topics will be covered: Pathology of calf and juvenile diseases, Pathology of adult cattle diseases, Postmortem evaluation of metabolic and nutritional diseases in cattle and A Pathologist's Most Memorable Bovine Cases. Topics will be discussed along organ systems, and include reproductive pathology, abortion diseases, teat and udder diseases, ocular and claw disorders. They will follow the sequence of primary congenital, degenerative, inflammatory and neoplastic disturbances. Most of the pathologic images will be presented at the gross level. When deemed necessary, microscopic and immunohistochemical images will be included. Didactic lectures will be combined with audience participation to result in an engrossing day-long seminar.
